What is Title V?

The mission of
EDUCATION CONNECTION's
Title V program is to provide job
training and placement for people with
limited financial resources who are
55 and older, and to provide employers
with trained, motivated workers.

What is Title V?

Title V, a senior community employment service program is a community and work-based training program for older workers. It was authorized by Congress in Title V of the Older Americans Act of 1965, to provide subsidized, part-time, community service work based training for low-income persons aged 55 or older who have poor employment prospects. Through this program, older workers have access to the SCSEP services as well as other employment assistance available through the One-Stop Career Centers of the Workforce Investment Act.

How Can **Title V** Help Me?

When you become a Title V trainee, you'll receive personalized help in meeting your goals. Maybe you would like to learn new skills, such as working with computers. Maybe it has been many years since you were in the workforce and you need help easing back into the working world. Maybe you just need help being placed in a job.

Where Do **Title V** Participants Train?

After receiving orientation, Title V participants are placed in a part-time job training position with local non-profit agencies such as libraries, community centers and social service organizations.

The salary of the enrollees is paid by the Senior Community Services Employment Program (SCSEP). This gives the agency a dedicated worker and provides the participant with experience and an opportunity to re-enter the workforce. Some enrollees may be hired by the non-profit agency after several months to a year in order to acquire new skills.

The ultimate goal is to find a good job in the public or private sector.
